Dear Members, Friends and Supporters,

Times are tough for an ever-increasing number of people in Ontario, and getting tougher all the time. Ontario's future looks bleak at best, dismal at worst.

Our daily news reports continually and increasingly repeat variations of the following stories and trends: all-time record debts; all-time record deficits; food prices rising to new heights; increasing poverty, unemployment, homelessness, drug addiction, and mental illness; daily reports of global Islamic terrorism; and of course the latest in who's being accused of racism/sexism. Electricity prices - still guaranteed to rise - are increasing well past the affordable level for many. Minimum wages now routinely increase, as does the incremental unemployment that they cause. All of these seemingly different symptoms have a common cause - the very politicians who promise to cure them.
